STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND SEVENTY-EIGHT.

AN ACT to amend section eight (8) of chapter one hundred and twenty of the revised statutes relating to larceny.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

Said section is hereby amended by adding at the end 2 thereof the following: "and any insurance agent, or 3 agent of any corporation, doing business in this state, 4 who shall appropriate to his own use any money or 5 substitute for money received by him as such agent or 6 shall refuse or neglect to pay over and deliver the 7 same to the party entitled to receive it for the space 8 of thirty days after written demand upon him therefor, 9 shall be deemed guilty of larceny and punished accord-

10 ingly.
