
IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND SEVENTY-EIGHT.

AN ACT in relation to husband and wife.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

In all matters of contract between husband and wife,

- 2 and for the preservation and protection of property, an
- 3 action at law may be maintained by wife against her
- 4 husband, and by husband against his wife, as if sole;
- 5 but neither shall be arrested on any writ in such action
- 6 nor on any execution issued on a judgment recovered
- 7 in any suit between said parties.
