STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND SEVENTY-EIGHT.

AN ACT to amend section two of chapter eighty-nine of the revised statutes, relating to reveiws.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

Section two of chapter eighty-nine of the revised
2 statutes, is hereby amended so as to read as follows :
3 *Sect. 2.* A petition for review may be signed by
4 the petitioner's attorney when the facts therein stated
5 are known to him, and the petitioner is out of the
6 state at the time of filing it; and the petition may be
7 inserted in a writ of attachment, and property attached
8 thereon, the same as on other writs; and notice there-
9 on may be ordered by the supreme judicial court, or
10 any justice thereof in term time or vacation, return-
11 able in the county where the judgment was rendered,
12 and it must be given accordingly.
