IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND  
SEVENTY-EIGHT.

AN ACT to repeal chapter seventy-eight of the public laws of one thousand eight hundred and seventy-six, relating to the erection of fish weirs and wharves in tide waters.

---

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows :*

SECTION 1. Chapter seventy-eight of the public laws of the year one thousand eight hundred and three seventy-six is hereby repealed.

SECT. 2. This act shall take effect when approved.
