Amendment proposed by Mr. KIMBALL of Bath, to bill an act
for the protection of Game and Birds.

Amend section twelve by adding after the words
2 “black duck,” the words “or other wild duck from
3 the first day of May to the first day of October follow-
4 ing, or any,” so that as amended the first part of said
5 section shall read as follows :

6 *Sect. 12.* No person shall kill or have in his pos-
7 session, except alive, or expose for sale, any wood duck
8 or dusky duck, commonly called black duck, or other
9 wild duck, from the first day of May to the first day
10 of October following, or any English snipe or wood-
11 cock between the first day of December and the first
12 day of September following ; &c., &c., &c.
