## STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND SEVENTY-EIGHT.

AN ACT additional to chapter ninety-seven of the revised statutes, relating to bastard children and their maintenance.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

Chapter ninety-seven of the revised statutes, is

- 2 hereby amended, by adding thereto the following
- 3 section:
- 4 Sect. 11. When the complainant dies after verdict
- 5 in her favor and before judgment, her executor or
- 6 administrator may prosecute her action to final judg-
- 7 ment; and the bond for the performance of the order
- 8 of the court, required by section seven of said chapter,
- 9 shall run to such executor or administrator; who,

- 10 after payment of the costs of prosecution, shall appro-
- 11 priate to the support of the child the money recovered
- 12 of the respondent.
