STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND SEVENTY-EIGHT.

AN ACT to amend chapter eighty-two of the revised statutes, relating to evidence.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

Section 1. Hereafter in the trial of any suit or pro-

- 2 ceeding at law or in equity, when a husband is a
- 3 party, his wife is a competent witness; and when a
- 4 wife is a party, her husband is a competent witness,
- 5 though the adverse party is a representative party.
 - Sect. 2. This act shall take effect when approved,
- 2 but shall not affect suits pending.
