STATE OF MAINE.

RESOLVE authorizing appointment of state geologist.

Resolved, That the governor be and hereby is authorized to appoint a geologist, whose duty it shall be to make examination, when called upon, of mines, minerals and ores found within the state, and to collect such statistical information in reference thereto as may be of interest and value to the people of the state; *provided*, that such service be rendered without compensation by the state, either as salary or for expenses.
