STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND SEVENTY-EIGHT.

AN ACT to amend section nine, of chapter three, of the revised statutes, relating to towns.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

Said section is hereby amended by inserting after the

- 2 word "resides," in the third line, the following words:
- 3 "and every female twenty-one years of age, or more,
- 4 qualified by residence in any town as required of male
- 5 voters," so that said section as amended shall read:
- 6 Sect. 9. Every person who is qualified by the con-
- 7 stitution of this state to vote for governor, senators,
- 8 and representatives, in the town where he resides, and
- 9 every female twenty-one years of age, or more, quali-
- 10 fied by residence in any town as required of male
- 11 voters, is entitled to vote in the election of all town
- 12 officers, and in all the business affairs thereof.
