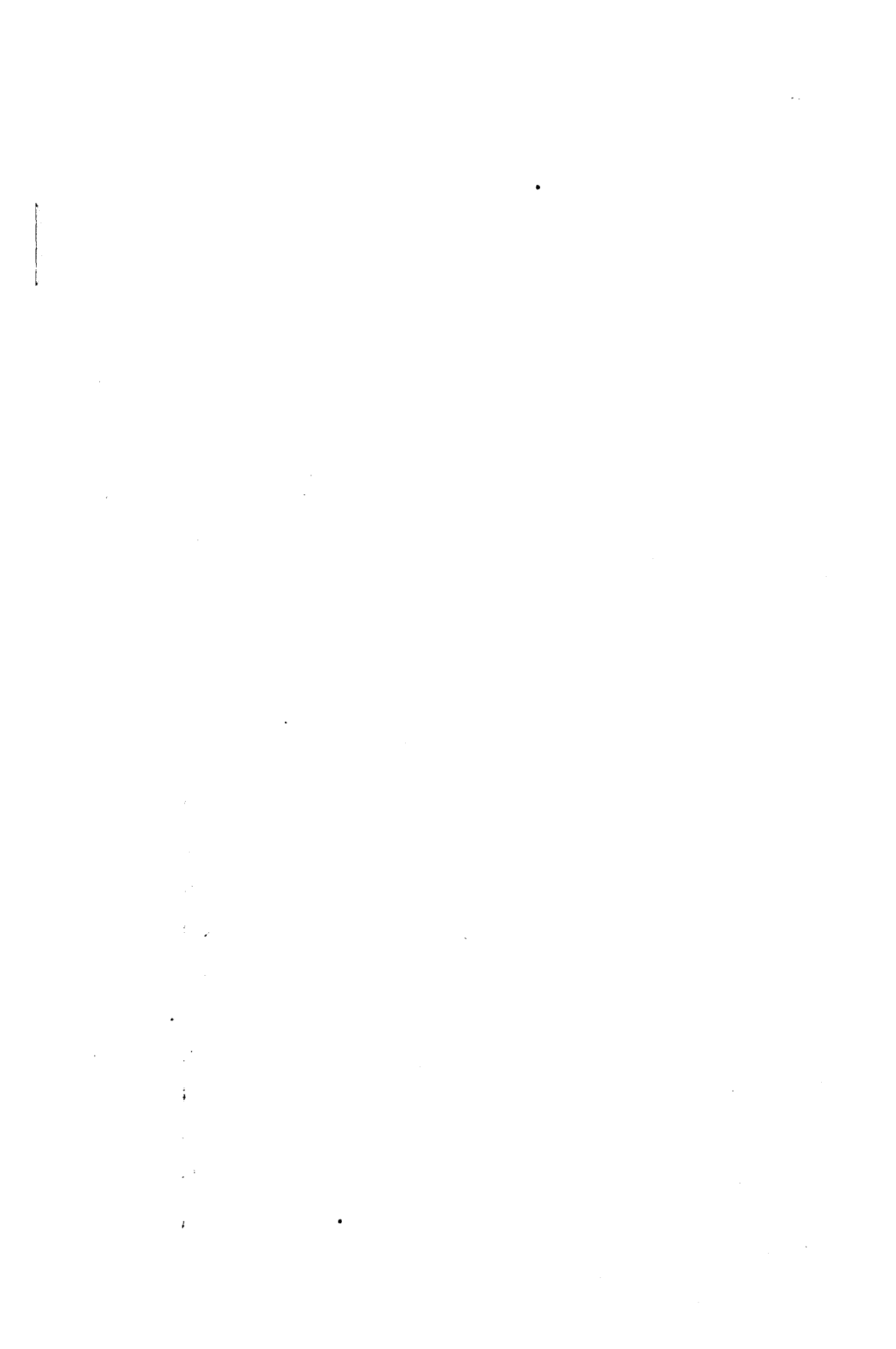

AN ACT to amend section nine, of chapter three, of the revised statutes, relating to towns.

---

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows :*

Said section is hereby amended by inserting after the  
2 word "resides," in the third line, the following words :  
3 " and every female twenty-one years of age, or more,  
4 qualified by residence in any town as required of male  
5 voters," so that said section as amended shall read :  
6 *Sect. 9.* Every person who is qualified by the con-  
7 stitution of this state to vote for governor, senators,  
8 and representatives, in the town where he resides, and  
9 every female twenty-one years of age, or more, quali-  
10 fied by residence in any town as required of male  
11 voters, is entitled to vote in the election of all town  
12 officers, and in all the business affairs thereof.
