STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND SEVENTY-EIGHT.

[S. 32.] AN ACT to amend section one of chapter two hundred and twenty-three of the public laws of eighteen hundred and seventy-one, relating to fares on railroads.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows :

Section one of chapter two hundred and twenty-three
2 of the public laws of eighteen hundred and seventy-
3 one, is hereby amended, by adding thereto the follow-
4 ing: "provided, that railroad companies may sell
5 special tickets, at less than the regular rates of fare,
6 to be used only as provided on the ticket," so that
7 said section, as amended, will read as follows :

8 *Sect. 1.* No railroad company shall limit the right
9 of a ticket holder to any given train, but such ticket

10 holder shall have the right to travel on any train,
11 whether regular or express train, and shall have the
12 privilege of stopping at any of the stations along the
13 line of the road at which such trains stop ; and such
14 tickets shall be good for a passage as above, for six
15 years from the day it was first used. *Provided, That*
16 railroad companies may sell special tickets at less than
17 the regular rates of fare, to be used only as provided
18 on the ticket.
