STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND SEVENTY-EIGHT.

[S. 39.] AN ACT additional to chapter forty-nine of the revised statutes, relating to life insurance.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

No life insurance company organized or incorporated 2 under the laws of this state shall be permitted to re-3 insure its risk, except by permission of the insurance 4 commissioner; but nothing in this act shall be con-5 strued to prevent any life insurance company from re-6 insuring a fractional part, not exceeding one-half of 7 any individual risk. • •
