STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND SEVENTY-EIGHT.

[S. 57.] AN ACT to amend chapter one hundred and forty-one of the public acts of eighteen hundred and seventy-six, relating to the settlement of the public lands.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

SECTION 1. That section two, of chapter one hundred
2 and forty-one of the public acts of eighteen hundred
3 and seventy-six is hereby amended by striking out of
4 the fifth line the words "which shall not be assignable,"
5 so that the last clause of said section shall read as
6 follows :

7 And a certificate shall be given, stating that he has
8 become a purchaser of said lot therein described, and

9 that he will be entitled to a deed when he complies
10 with the requirements of law.

SECT. 2. That all certificates heretofore, as well as
2 those hereafter granted, are hereby made assignable,
3 and in them the provisions of sections thirty-two,
4 thirty-three, thirty-five and thirty-six of chapter five
5 of the revised statutes.

SECT. 3. This act takes effect upon its approval.
