STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND SEVENTY-EIGHT.

[S. 38.] AN ACT to facilitate the transfer to the United States of the title to the Antietam National Cemetery, in the State of Maryland.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

That the State of Maryland be and is hereby authorized to convey to the United States, all the right, title and interest of the State of Maine in and to the land occupied by the Antietam National Cemetery, in the county of Washington, in the said State of Maryland, and if the said State of Maryland shall have already made such transfer of title to the United States, the assent thereto of the State of Maine is hereby granted.

10 transmit a copy of this act to the president of the
11 United States, and to the governor of the State of
12 Maryland.
