STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND SEVENTY-EIGHT.

[H. R. 10.] AN ACT to prevent the throwing of edgings, sawdust and other refuse into the waters of the harbor of Wiscasset.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

SECTION 1. It shall be unlawful for any person or 2 persons to throw any buttings, edgings, sawdust, shav- 3 ings, or other waste, made in the sawing or manufac- 4 ing of lumber, into the waters of the harbor of Wis- 5 casset, or to so place or pile the same upon the banks 6 of said harbor or elsewhere, that they shall be liable to 7 fall or be washed into said harbor.

SECT. 2. If any person or persons shall violate the 3 provisions of this act, he or they shall be subject to a 4 penalty or fine of not more than twenty dollars, nor

5 less than five dollars, for each violation of this act,
6 upon complaint and conviction before any court of
7 competent jurisdiction.

SECT. 3. This act shall take effect when approved.
