STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND SEVENTY-EIGHT.

[H. R. 66.] AN ACT additional to chapter nineteen of the public laws of the year one thousand eight hundred and seventy-five, relating to the taxation of rail road companies.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

SECTION 1. Any railroad company which has here-2 tofore omitted to apply to the governor and council, 3 under chapter nineteen of the public acts of the year 4 one thousand eight hundred and seventy-five, for an 5 abatement of valuation claimed to be excessive, and 6 whose claim for such abatement is barred by the limi-7 tation contained in said chapter, is hereby permitted 8 to apply, in writing, to the governor and council, at

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9 any time within sixty days from the approval of this10 act by the governor, for an abatement of the excess11 of valuation of said company for any previous year.

SECT. 2. Any abatement made by the governor and 2 council under this act shall be of no effect, unless the 3 railroad company shall pay the arrearages of taxes due 4 into the state treasury within four months after the ad-5 judication of the governor and council.
