STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND
SEVENTY-EIGHT.

[H. R. 8.] AN ACT to amend section forty-eight, chapter eighteen of the revised statutes, relating to highway taxes.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

Section forty-eight of chapter eighteen of the revised statutes is hereby amended by adding the following words: "and the treasurer shall hold the same subject to the order of the selectmen, to be applied by them for repairs of roads and bridges," so that said section as amended shall read as follows:

Sect. 48. Each surveyor at the expiration of his term is to render to the assessors a list of such persons as have not worked out or paid their taxes. The assessors are to place the amounts due from each in dis-

11 tinct columns in the next assessment of town taxes on
12 such delinquents, to be collected as other town taxes,
13 and paid to the treasurer, and the treasurer shall hold
14 the same subject to the order of the selectmen, to be
15 applied by them for repairs of roads and bridges.
