Resolved, That the sum of seventy-five dollars be
2 appropriated for repairing the bridge over Molunkus

STATEMENT OF FACTS

For Senate Document No. 53, entitled "Resolve for repairing bridge over Molunkus stream in Macwahoc plantation."

The Molunkus bridge is situate on the Maine military road in Macwahoc plantation. This is a covered bridge, with granite abutments, and was built by the State a few years since. The bridge was thoroughly constructed, but the planking was laid lengthwise, and are so worn that it has become necessary to cross-plank the bridge, and also to gravel the approaches. The estimated cost of these repairs is seventy-five dollars.

State entered into an agreement with the United States in the year 1834, to keep this road in repair. See Resolves of State of Maine, approved March 8, 1834, and United States Statutes at large, vol. 4, page 716.
