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## STATE OF MAINE.

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IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND  
SEVENTY-EIGHT.

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[S. 26.] AN ACT amending chapter one hundred and  
twenty-four of the public laws of the year eighteen  
hundred and seventy-six, relating to warehouses.

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*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives  
in Legislature assembled, as follows :*

Section four of said act of eighteen hundred and  
2 seventy-six, is amended by inserting after “ware-  
3 house” in the second line of said section four, “or  
4 on the wharves and premises of the warehouseman  
5 and in his possession,” so that said section four shall  
6 read as follows :

7 “The title to goods and chattels stored in a public  
8 warehouse, or on the wharves and premises of the  
9 warehouseman, shall pass to a purchaser or pledgee,  
10 in good faith, by the indorsement to such purchaser or

11 pledgee, but not in blank, of the warehouseman's  
12 receipt therefor signed by the person to whom the  
13 receipt was originally given, or by an indorsee of the  
14 receipt, and recorded in the books of the warehouse-  
15 man with whom such goods and chattels are stored."
