## STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND SEVENTY-EIGHT.

[S. 26.] AN ACT amending chapter one hundred and twenty-four of the public laws of the year eighteen hundred and seventy-six, relating to warehouses.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

Section four of said act of eighteen hundred and

- 2 seventy-six, is amended by inserting after "ware-
- 3 house" in the second line of said section four, "or
- 4 on the wharves and premises of the warehouseman
- 5 and in his possession," so that said section four shall
- 6 read as follows:
- 7 "The title to goods and chattels stored in a public
- 8 warehouse, or on the wharves and premises of the
- 9 warehouseman, shall pass to a purchaser or pledgee,
- 10 in good faith, by the indorsement to such purchaser or

- 11 pledgee, but not in blank, of the warehouseman's
- 12 receipt therefor signed by the person to whom the
- 13 receipt was originally given, or by an indorsee of the
- 14 receipt, and recorded in the books of the warehouse-
- 15 man with whom such goods and chattels are stored."
