STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND
SEVENTY-EIGHT.

[S. 70.] AN ACT to establish the salary of the clerk of
courts for the county of Penobscot.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives
in Legislature assembled, as follows:*

The Clerk of Penobscot County shall receive an
2 annual salary of fifteen hundred dollars, and an addi-
3 tional annual allowance of eight hundred dollars for
4 clerk hire. Said sums shall be in full compensation
5 for the performance of all duties required of him by
6 law, including those performed by him as Clerk of the
7 County Commissioners, or by a clerk pro tempore
8 appointed by him under section seven of chapter
9 seventy-eight. He shall render an account of all fees
10 of office as required by law, be responsible for the

11 same whether received or not, and pay the whole
12 amount to the Treasurer of the county for the use
13 thereof. One clerk employed by him shall be known
14 as Deputy Clerk, and sworn as such, and shall give to
15 the clerk a bond for his honesty and the faithful
16 discharge of his duties.

17 This act to take effect April first, eighteen hundred
18 and seventy-eight.
