STATE OF MAINE.

[S. 24.] RESOLVE relating to the state college of
agriculture and the mechanic arts.

Resolved, That the governor and council are hereby
2 requested to indicate in any way they may think
3 proper, their readiness to receive proposals from de-
4 nominations, associations, or organizations, to take
5 from the state the state college of agriculture and the
6 mechanic arts at Orono, and agree to so sustain it,
7 according to its original plan, as to protect the rights
8 of all parties, and report to the next legislature.
