[S. 82.] AN ACT to define the qualifications of town
officers.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives
in Legislature assembled, as follows:*

No person shall be eligible to the office of plantation
2 assessor, plantation clerk, or member of the board of
3 selectmen of a town, unless such person can read and
4 write.
