STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND SEVENTY-NINE.

AN ACT to abolish imprisonment for debt in certain cases.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

SECTION 1. No person shall be arrested or imprisoned on mesne process in a suit on contract, express or implied, or on any execution issued on a judgment on such contract, where such contract was made after this act shall take effect.

SECT. 2. The form of executions issued on such judgments shall be varied in accordance with the provisions of this act.

SECT. 3. Nothing herein contained shall repeal or affect any of the provisions of chapter sixty-seven of the public laws of eighteen hundred and seventy-

4 eight, entitled "an act to provide additional reme-
5 dies for the enforcement of judgments."

SECT. 4. All acts and parts of acts inconsistent
2 with this act are hereby repealed.

SECT. 5. This act shall take effect on the fourth
2 day of July, A. D. eighteen hundred and seventy-
3 nine.
