RESOLVE in favor of the town of Glenburn.

---

*Resolved,* That there be paid by the treasurer of  
2 state, out of the school funds for the current year,  
3 to the town of Glenburn, one hundred and fifty-  
4 nine dollars and seventy-five cents, it being the  
5 balance due said town in equity, owing to a mis-  
6 take made by the supervisor thereof in eighteen  
7 hundred and seventy-eight.

## STATEMENT OF FACTS.

---

To the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled :

The undersigned, municipal officers of the town of Glenburn, respectfully represent, that by an error of the Supervisor of Schools in said town, in his returns made as provided by law to the State Superintendent of Common Schools, for the year ending April 1, 1878, school money has been apportioned to said town by the State Treasurer, for the current school year ending April 1, 1879, for 176 (one hundred seventy-six) scholars, while said town was actually entitled to money for 276 scholars.

They, therefore, in behalf of said town, respectfully petition that your honorable body may authorize the State Treasurer to correct the mistake so made, by apportioning to said town for the ensuing school year a sum additional to which it may be entitled for that year, equal to the amount lost thereto by said error. And as in duty bound will ever pray.
