STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND SEVENTY-NINE.

AN ACT additional relative to the Boston and Maine railroad.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

The Boston and Maine railroad may by a vote of
2 its directors or stockholders, discontinue the loca-
3 tion of so much of its railroad as lies between the
4 westerly side of Portland street, in the village of
5 South Berwick, and the junction of the Boston and
6 Maine railroad with the Portland, Saco and Ports-
7 mouth railroad at South Berwick junction, so
8 called; and thereupon may remove therefrom the
9 superstructure and buildings owned by said cor-
10 poration, and shall be relieved from the duty of
11 operating said portion of its railroad.
