STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND SEVENTY-NINE.

AN ACT to extend the time for taking smelts in the Penobscot river and its tributaries.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

SECTION 1. The provisions and penalties of sec-2 tion eleven of chapter seventy-five of the public 3 laws of the year eighteen hundred and seventy-4 eight, shall not apply to smelts taken in the Penob-5 scot river and its tributaries, between the first and 6 fifteenth days of April of each year; otherwise said 7 provisions and penalties shall remain in full force.

SECT. 2. This act shall take effect when approved.
