STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND SEVENTY-NINE.

AN ACT to amend an "act additional to chapter ninety-seven of the revised statutes, relating to bastard children and their maintenance," approved February nineteen, eighteen hundred and seventyeight.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

Said act is hereby amended so as to read as follows: 2 Sect. 11. When the complainant dies before trial 3 her executor or administrator may prosecute her 4 action to final judgment, and in case of judgment 5 against the respondent, the bond for the perform-6 ance of the order of court required by section seven 7 of said chapter shall run to such executor or admin-
