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## STATE OF MAINE.

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IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND SEVENTY-NINE.

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AN ACT to amend an "act additional to chapter ninety-seven of the revised statutes, relating to bastard children and their maintenance," approved February nineteen, eighteen hundred and seventy-eight.

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*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:*

Said act is hereby amended so as to read as follows:

2   *Sect. 11.* When the complainant dies before trial  
3 her executor or administrator may prosecute her  
4 action to final judgment, and in case of judgment  
5 against the respondent, the bond for the perform-  
6 ance of the order of court required by section seven  
7 of said chapter shall run to such executor or admin-

8 istrator, who, after payment of the costs of prose-  
9 cution shall appropriate to the support of the child  
10 the money received of the respondent.
