## STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND SEVENTY-NINE.

AN ACT to amend chapter one hundred and twentyseven of the revised statutes, relating to trespass.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

Section ten of said chapter is hereby repealed,

- 2 and the following inserted instead thereof:
- 3 Sect. 10. Whoever wilfully enters on or passes
- 4 over the garden, orchard, mowing land or other
- 5 inclosed or cultivated land of another, at any time
- 6 between the first day of April and the first day of
- 7 December of each year, after being forbidden so to
- 8 do by the owner or occupant of said land or his
- 9 agent, either personally or by notice posted con-
- 10 spicuously on the premises, shall be guilty of tres-

- 11 pass and punished by fine not exceeding twenty
- 12 dollars, and the provisions of section twelve of this
- 13 chapter shall apply to violations of this section.
