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## STATE OF MAINE.

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IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND SEVENTY-NINE.

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AN ACT to amend chapter one hundred and thirty-nine of the public laws of eighteen hundred and seventy-three.

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*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:*

Chapter one hundred and thirty-nine of the public laws of eighteen hundred and seventy-three, is hereby amended, so as to read as follows:

*Sect. 1.* When the plaintiff in an action dies before the expiration of thirty days from the rendition of judgment in his favor, or before the expiration of thirty days after the next term of court in the county where the action was pending, in cases where a certificate of decision, provided for in chapter seventy-seven of the revised statutes, shall

11 be received by the clerk of said county, in vaca-  
12 tion, and no suggestion of such death has been  
13 made upon the docket of said county, execution  
14 may issue as is now provided, and all attachments  
15 then in force shall continue ninety days after the  
16 next term of the court in that county; and if the  
17 defendant was arrested on mesne process, and gave  
18 bond to disclose after judgment, he may do so after  
19 said next term without breach of his bond.

SECT. 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
