STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND SEVENTY-NINE.

AN ACT to extend the time for locating and completing the Northern Aroostook Railroad.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

A further time of two years from January first,

- 2 eighteen hundred and eighty, is hereby granted to
- 3 the Northern Aroostook railroad company, within
- 4 which to make and file the location of its line of
- 5 railroad; and a further time of two years from
- 6 January first, eighteen hundred and eighty-two, is
- 7 also hereby granted to said railroad company to
- 8 complete and finish its line of railroad.

Amendment "A" proposed by Mr. LEWIS of Sherman.

Provided, That said railroad company shall, within 2 said time, locate and construct its line of railroad 3 from some point on the railroad of the consolidated 4 ted European and North American railway company in the town of Mattawamkeag, from thence 6 up the Penobscot river to Salmon stream or Nicatou, and from thence by the most feasible route to 8 the town of Houlton, with power to further extend 9 said line of railroad from any point on the route 10 above mentioned to Presque Isle or its vicinity, 11 and from thence to the St. John river in or near 12 the town of Van Buren.
