### STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND: SEVENTY-NINE.

AN ACT to amend chapter twenty-two, section six, of the revised statutes of eighteen hundred seventy-one.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

Section six of chapter twenty-two of the revised

- 2 statutes, is amended by adding to said section the
- 3 following words: "And shall have a lien on the
- 4 land owned or occupied by the party neglecting or
- 5 refusing to build or maintain the partition fence
- 6 assigned to him by the fence viewers therefor, to be
- 7 enforced by attachment made within one year from
- 8 the day of division by the fence viewers;" so that
- 9 said section as amended shall read as follows:

#### HOUSE-No. 29.

10 Sect. 6. If any party refuses or neglects to build 11 and maintain the part thus assigned him, it may 12 be done by the aggrieved party, and he shall be 13 entitled to the double value and expenses ascer-14 tained and to be recovered as provided in section 15 four, and shall have a lien on the land owned or 16 occupied by the party neglecting or refusing to 17 build or maintain the partition fence assigned to 18 him by the fence viewers therefor, to be enforced 19 by attachment made within one year from the day 20 of division by the fence viewers.
