STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND SEVENTY-NINE.

AN ACT to amend section one of chapter one hundred twenty-four of the revised statutes.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

Section one of chapter one hundred twenty-four 2 of the revised statutes is hereby amended so as to 3 read as follows:

- 4 Sect. 1. Whoever commits adultery shall be
- 5 punished by imprisonment not more than five years
- 6 or by fine not exceeding one thousand dollars; and
- 7 when only one of the parties is married, and when
- 8 they have been legally divorced from the bonds of
- 9 matrimony, and afterwards cohabit, each shall be
- 10 deemed guilty of adultery.
