STATE OF MAINE.

RESOLVE to amend chapter one hundred and fifty-four of the resolves of eighteen hundred and seventy, entitled resolve in favor of Maine Central Institute.

Resolved, That chapter one hundred and fifty-four 2 of the resolves of eighteen hundred and seventy, 3 entitled a resolve in favor of Maine Central Insti- 4 tute, be and is hereby amended, by adding the word 5 “five,” after the words “eighteen hundred and 6 eighty,” in the sixth line thereof, so that said 7 resolve, as amended, shall read as follows:

8 Resolved, That the sum of ten thousand dollars 9 be and hereby is appropriated out of the state 10 treasury, for the use of the trustees of the Maine 11 Central Institute, as endowment fund to said insti- 12 tution, the money to be retained in the treasury, 13 and the interest to be paid semi-annually till the

14 year one thousand eight hundred and eighty-five;
15 and if at that time the said trustees shall own
16 unincumbered school property to the amount of
17 forty thousand dollars, and the said institution shall
18 be in successful operation, the said sum of ten
19 thousand dollars shall be paid to the trustees of
20 said institution for the use and benefit thereof; and
21 they shall safely invest the same, the interest only
22 to be expended annually; *provided*, that the trus-
23 tees of said institution, in consideration of the aid
24 thus rendered by the state, shall, within one year
25 after the passage of this resolve, establish and
26 thereafter maintain a normal department for the
27 preparation of teachers.
