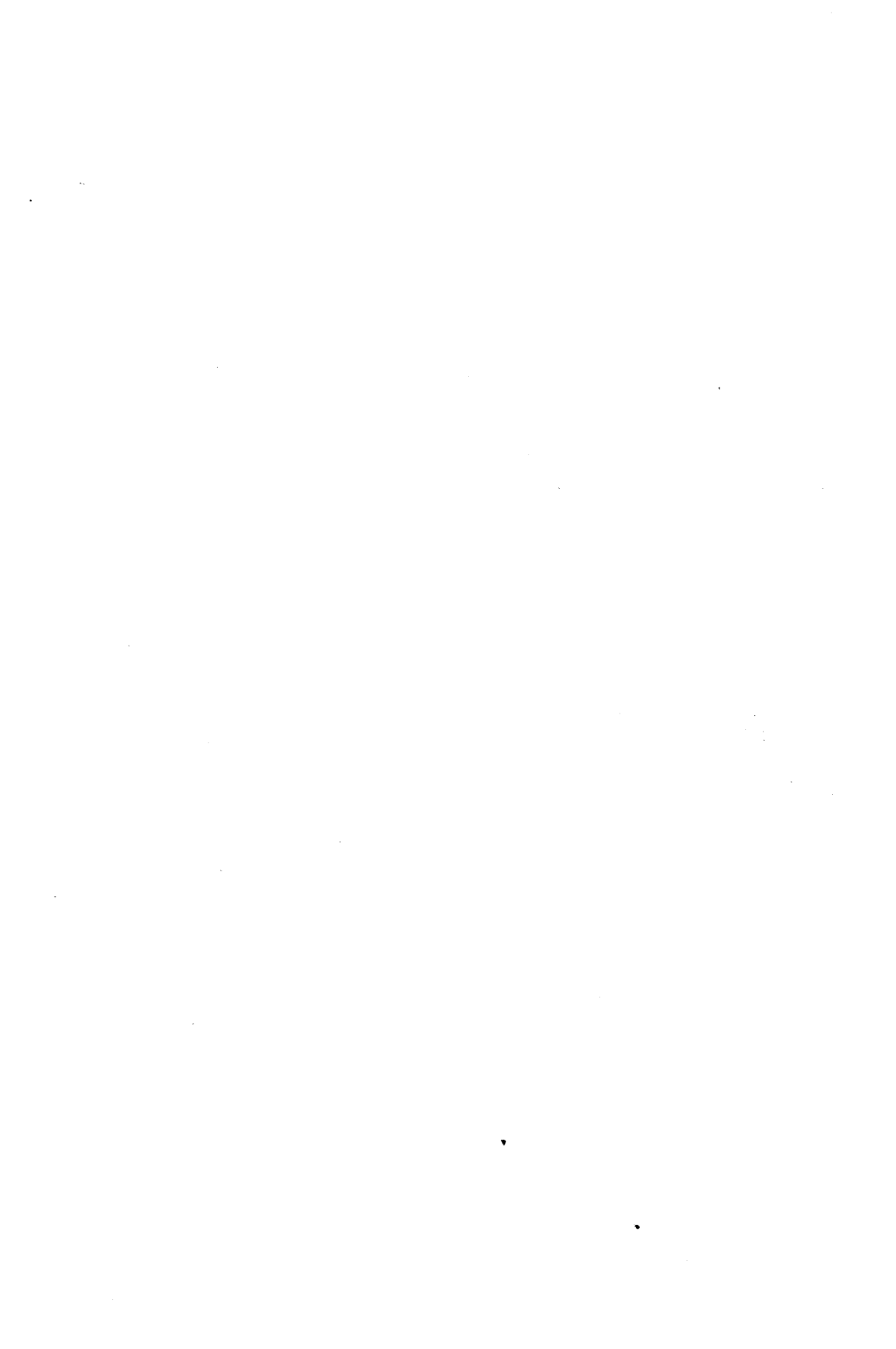
STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND SEVENTY-NINE.

AN ACT to repeal chapters one hundred and fifteen and one hundred and twenty-four of the acts of eighteen hundred and seventy-three.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

The act entitled “an act in aid of free high
2 schools,” approved February twenty-four, eighteen
3 hundred and seventy-three, and the act entitled
4 “an act to enable academies to surrender their
5 property to cities, towns and plantations for the
6 benefit of free high schools,” approved February
7 twenty-four, eighteen hundred and seventy-three,
8 be and the same are hereby repealed.
