STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND SEVENTY-NINE.

AN ACT additional to chapter thirty-one of the revised statutes, as amended by chapter one hundred and twenty-four of the public laws of eighteen hundred and seventy-six, relating to agents and warehouse-men.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

The following section is hereby added to chapter 2 thirty-one of the revised statutes, as amended.

3 *Sect. 9.* When grain or other property is stored
4 in a public warehouse in such a manner that dif-
5 ferent lots or parcels are mixed together, so that
6 the identity of the same cannot be accurately pre-
7 served, the warehouse-man's receipt for any portion
8 of such grain or property shall be deemed a valid.

9 title to so much thereof as is designated in said
10 receipt, without regard to any separation or identi-
11 fication.
