STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND SEVENTY-NINE.

AN ACT to amend chapter two hundred and seven of the public laws of the year one thousand eight hundred and seventy-seven, entitled "an act to obtain uniform returns from railroad corporations."

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

The last clause of chapter two hundred and seven 2 of the public laws of the year one thousand eight 3 hundred and seventy-seven, is hereby amended, 4 by striking out the word "hundred" and inserting 5 instead thereof the word "thousand," and by adding 6 at the end of said clause the words "to be recov-7 ered in an action of the case, or by complaint and 8 indictment, in any court having competent juris-9 diction; and it shall be the duty of the railroad

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10 commissioners to notify the attorney general of11 such neglect, who shall prosecute for the recovery12 of such forfeiture," so that said clause, as amended,13 shall read as follows:

14 "If any railroad corporation shall wilfully neg-15 lect to make such return, it shall forfeit one thou-16 sand dollars to the use of the state, to be recovered 17 in an action of the case, or by complaint and indict-18 ment, in any court having competent jurisdiction; 19 and it shall be the duty of the railroad commis-20 sioners to notify the attorney general of such neg-21 lect, who shall prosecute for the recovery of such 22 forfeiture."
