AN ACT to prevent disturbance in public assemblies.

---

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:*

Whoever by rude and indecent behavior, disturbs  
2 any public meeting or assembly, or creates any  
3 disturbance in any hall, walk, or corridor adjacent,  
4 or leading to the rooms where such public meeting  
5 or assembly may be held, shall be punished by a  
6 fine not less than five dollars, or imprisonment not  
7 exceeding thirty days.
