## STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND SEVENTY-NINE.

AN ACT to prevent disturbance in public assemblies.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

Whoever by rude and indecent behavior, disturbs

- 2 any public meeting or assembly, or creates any
- 3 disturbance in any hall, walk, or corridor adjacent,
- 4 or leading to the rooms where such public meeting
- 5 or assembly may be held, shall be punished by a
- 6 fine not less than five dollars, or imprisonment not
- 7 exceeding thirty days.
