STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND SEVENTY-NINE.

AN ACT to exempt domestic fowl from attachment and execution.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

Domestic fowl, not exceeding fifty dollars in value, 2 shall be and is hereby exempt from attachment and 3 execution.
