RESOLVE in favor of Mapleton plantation in the
county of Aroostook.

Resolved, That the sum of three hundred dollars
2 be appropriated and paid to the plantation of
3 Mapleton, in the county of Aroostook, to reimburse
4 said plantation, in part, for money expended in
5 re-building bridge over Presque Isle stream, said
6 bridge having been destroyed by fire in the year
7 eighteen hundred and seventy-seven.
