STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND SEVENTY-NINE.

AN ACT to provide in part for the expenditures of government.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

SECTION 1. In order to provide for the several
2 acts and resolves of the legislature, requiring the
3 payment of money from the treasury, and also to
4 provide for the necessary expenditures of govern-
5 ment for the current fiscal year, the following sums
6 are hereby appropriated out of any moneys in the
7 treasury, and the governor, with the advice and
8 consent of the council, is hereby authorized, at any
9 time prior to the first day of January next, to draw
10 his warrant on the treasury for the same.
