#### STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND SEVENTY-NINE.

### AN ACT requiring a jury fee.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

Section 1. There shall be paid to the clerk of

- 2 the supreme judicial court, and to the clerks of the
- 3 superior courts for Cumberland and Kennebec
- 4 counties respectively, by the plaintiff or appellant,
- 5 five dollars for the trial by jury of each civil action,
- 6 for the use of the county, to be taxed with his
- 7 costs, if he prevails, and the clerk shall forthwith
- 8 pay over the same to the county treasury.

Sect. 2. This act shall take effect when approved.
