### AN ACT requiring a jury fee.

---

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:*

SECTION 1. There shall be paid to the clerk of  
2 the supreme judicial court, and to the clerks of the  
3 superior courts for Cumberland and Kennebec  
4 counties respectively, by the plaintiff or appellant,  
5 five dollars for the trial by jury of each civil action,  
6 for the use of the county, to be taxed with his  
7 costs, if he prevails, and the clerk shall forthwith  
8 pay over the same to the county treasury.

SECT. 2. This act shall take effect when approved.
