STATE OF MAINE.

RESOLVE in favor of the town of Fort Kent.

Resolved, That the sum of thirty-five dollars and
2 fifty-two cents be paid Fort Kent, being the amount
3 abated and allowed said town of Fort Kent, under
4 resolve of March six, A. D. eighteen hundred and
5 sixty-nine. And that the further sum of twenty-
6 one dollars and twenty-six cents be allowed and
7 paid Fort Kent, said sum being the amount deducted
8 by the state from funds belonging to Fort Kent,
9 the treasurer supposing said sum should be assumed
10 by said town, in part payment of tax assessed to
11 Daigle plantation.
