STATE OF MAINE.

RESOLVE relating to the lands of the Passamaquoddy.

Indians.

Resolved, That the governor is hereby authorized 2 and requested to ascertain the value of the land 3 taken from the Passamaquoddy Indians, under 4 chapter three hundred thirty-six of the resolves of 5 eighteen hundred and sixty, and determine if in his 6 opinion the legislature had the right under the 7 treaty stipulations with said Indians, to give their 8 lands away for any purposes whatever, and report 9 to the next legislature whether in his opinion the 10 lands so given away should be restored to them, 11 or its equivalent in money be deposited in the state 12 treasury as a trust fund for the benefit of said 13 tribe, the interest to be annually expended for 14 them; and also to ascertain if any persons are 15 trespassing or living upon their land (or any part

- 16 thereof) near the town of Lubec in Washington
- 17 county, and take such measures as he may deem
- 18 proper, to give said Indians their rights and estab-
- 19 lish the bounds of said lot of land.
