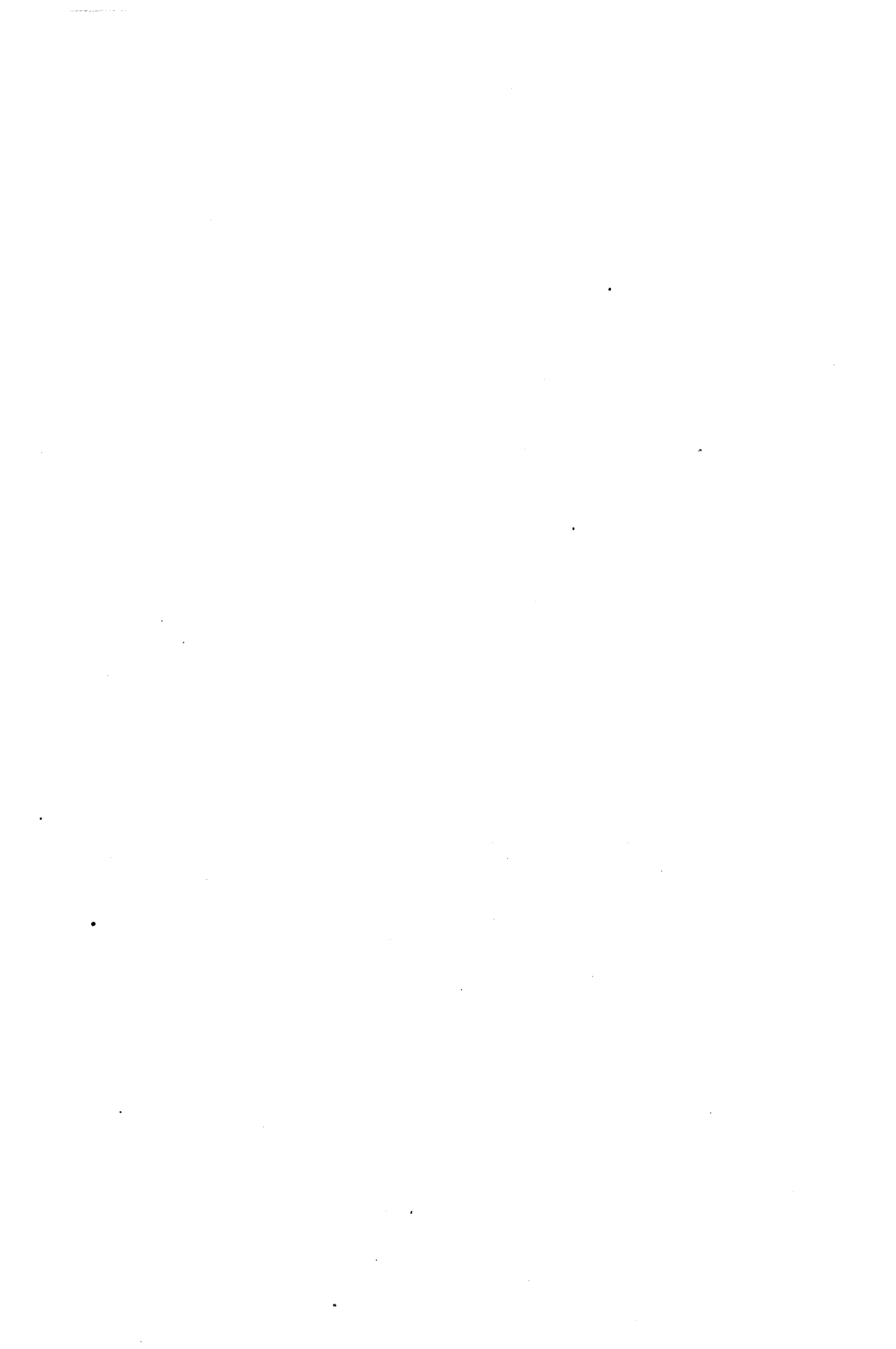

### AN ACT to confirm deeds and bonds.

---

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:*

That all deeds and other conveyances of real  
2 estate and instruments which purport to have been  
3 intended as bonds, with conditions under seal, which  
4 have been executed without seal, shall be valid as  
5 though the same had been sealed: *Provided*, that  
6 this act shall not affect any suit now pending.
