IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND SEVENTY-NINE.

AN ACT relating to costs.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

Section one hundred and eleven of chapter eighty-

- 2 two of the revised statutes, is hereby amended, so
- 3 as to read as follows:
- 4 Sect. 111. When any plaintiff shall in any stage
- 5 of his action become non-suit, or discontinue his
- 6 suit, the defendant shall recover his costs against
- 7 him; and in all actions, as well those of qui tam as
- 8 others, the party prevailing shall be entitled to his
- 9 legal costs. When costs have been allowed against
- 10 a plaintiff on non-suit or discontinuance, and a
- 11 second suit is brought for the same cause, before
- 12 the costs of the former suit are paid, further pro-

13 ceedings shall be stayed, till such costs are paid,14 and the suit may be dismissed, unless they are paid15 at such time as the court appoints.
