AMENDMENT "A."

To amend section one, by striking out all after
2 the word "namely" in the third line, to and includ-
3 ing the word "Thomaston" in the seventh line,
4 and insert thereof the following words, to wit:

5 "Commencing at the line of the town of Camden,
6 on the west side of the old county road, so called;
7 thence southwesterly, as the line of said road runs,
8 to the line of the town of Thomaston."

AMENDMENT "B."

To amend section six, by striking out the word
2 "final" in the thirtieth line, and inserting instead
3 thereof the following words:

4 "Returned to the supreme judicial court, next to
5 be holden after said hearing, in said county of

6 Knox, which shall have power to affirm or recom-
7 mit said report as justice may require, and when
8 accepted and affirmed by said court said report shall
9 be final.”
